Josquin Lebloitte dit des Prez (b. c. 1450–d. 27 August 1521), known as Josquin des Prez or Josquin, was born in the French-language area of Flanders, what is now northeastern France and Belgium, possibly in the village of St-Sauveur, but his strongest connection was to the city of Cond -sur-L'Escaut, where he inherited considerable property from relatives in the 1480s and where he moved permanently in his last years as canon and provost of the Collegiate Church of Notre Dame.
